**EVENT SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**1 RULES**

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)*, *MBSA Notice of Race and General Sailing Instructions* except as changed by these *Event Sailing Instructions*.

The Phil Small is a qualifier for the PHRF Marblehead Season series and the Mass Bay Season Championship.

**2 ENTRIES**

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and paying the \$40.00 entry fee to Jubilee Yacht Club to the competitors meeting or the Jubilee Yacht Club business office. Entries must be submitted before 0900 on Sunday, October 1, 2006. Member discounts are \$5 for US Sailing and \$5 for MBSA. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.

All JYC racing season pass holders are entitled to race at no further cost, but absolutely should submit an entry form.

**3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the Jubilee Yacht Club.

**4 RADIO USE and ANNOUNCEMENTS**

Race Committee Will monitor VHF 72 from 0900 until one hour after racing ends for the day. Any changes to the race schedule will be announced at 0900 on VHF 72. Please refrain from hailing the Race Committee during the starting sequences.

**5 SCHEDULE**

A competitors' meeting will be held at 0900, Sunday October 1, 2006, in the JYC great hall prior to the race. The warning signal for the race will be at 1100 October 1, 2006.

**6 CLASS FLAGS**

For both races classes will start in the following order

Flag A = PHRF A

Flag B = PHRF B

Flag J = J105

Flag C = PHRF C

Flag D = PHRF D

Flag E = PHRF E

Flag F = PHRF Cruising F

Flag G = PHRF Cruising G

Flag M = Multihull

Class Starts may be combined at the discretion of the race committee. Monitor VHF 72.

**7 RACING AREA**

The Racing area will be in the vicinity of Salem Bay with the start in the vicinity of G13, Curtis Point. However any marks on the MBSA mark lists A & B or inflatable may be used. The Race Committee may hoist the Lima "follow me" and move the start as needed.

**8 COURSE and MARKS**

MBSA Standard Rounding Marks, Lists A & B, or MBSA Standard Courses, using inflatable marks.

## **9 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES; STARTING SYSTEM]**

The starting and finishing lines will be between the flag on the JYC RC boat and the nearest mark. The Race Committee will attempt to hail premature starters on VHF 72. Failure to hail will not be cause for redress.

## **10 TIME LIMIT**

The time limit Shall be three hours from the start of each class. The time limit may be extended by the Race Committee on VHF 72.

## **11 PROTESTS**

Protests shall be delivered to Jubilee Yacht Club Regatta Committee Office within 1 hour after the race committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the notice board outside the Regatta Committee Office on the first floor. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing in the Jubilee Yacht Club.

## **12 SCORING**

The Rindele scoring System will be used. One race is scheduled which constitutes a series.

### **Social Activities**

All captains, crew and guests are invited to the Jubilee Yacht Club for complimentary Beer and Chowder. Trophies will be presented.
